**WHAT YOU MUST DO TO FINISH YOUR DEGREE!**

Apply for graduation by filing a *Declaration of Candidacy for Degree form* with the Evaluations Department (via the student's campus) two sessions before the anticipated degree completion date.

\*\*General Electives will vary depending upon how many required courses are taken in such a way as to apply to more than one requirement. Ex. PHIL-330 applies to the Ethics requirement and also applies to the Upper Level requirement. One 3 SH course fulfills 6 SH of credit in this example. Some double-dipping is built in such as UL courses in the major.

Note: CC does not accept ACE vocational credit recommendations. Credit must be at the lower-division baccalaureate/associate or upper-division baccalaureate level for consideration.
