

COLUMBIA COLLEGE STUDENT ART SHOW ENTRY FORM

Its time again for the annual Columbia College Student Show! **This year, each student may enter up to three pieces, only two of which may be in the same media; however all three may be in the same category.** (For example, a student may enter two oil paintings and a watercolor in the painting category). Depending on the number of pieces which are entered, the show may be juried. If there are more entries than may be displayed, a judge (who is not affiliated with Columbia College) will select the best work entered to be displayed.

Deadlines:

All art work and entry forms are due to the **Drawing Room on Wednesday, March 21st** by 5pm. Place the entry form (page 2) in the envelope provided. If your work is not accepted to the show, it must be picked up on **Monday, April 2nd**. Those pieces which are accepted must be picked up on **Friday, April 13th**.

Requirements:

All pieces **MUST** be framed and ready for display! This means you need to have **HANGING WIRE** on the back of your work, or it will not be considered for the show. The Art Department faculty reserves the right to refuse an artwork if it is not matted and/or framed properly. Each work **MUST** also have a label attached to the back (found on page 3). Furthermore, all work must have been created within the past year.

Categories:

Please indicate the category of your work on the piece's label. This will be the category in which the piece is judged.

- A. Painting
- B. Photography
- C. Graphic Design and Illustration
- D. Drawing and Printmaking
- E. 3-Dimensional (sculpture, jewelry, ceramics, etc)

Sales:

You have the option of selling your artwork. To do this, please indicate "yes" on the label and entry form. Interested buyers will be able to contact Elaine in the art office for information. The insurance price you indicate will automatically be used as your selling price.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded at the show opening, the date of which will be announced later. The prizes will be awarded as follows:

Best of Category- these awards will be decided by the show's judge.

Best of Show- this award is given to the piece which receives the most votes from fellow students and the general public.
