Acceptable Payment Methods:

Columbia College students may pay with cash, money order or check made out to CC. Non-Columbia College students must pay with cash or money order made out to Columbia College. No payment will be accepted at the time of the exam.

CBASE Fee \$50.00

The CBASE fee is due at the time of scheduling. No money will be accepted the night of the exam. The fee is transferable if the examinee reschedules in advance. "No Shows" will not be granted fee transfer and are required to pay an additional \$50 should they test at a later date. All examinees must be on time. **Proctors will not allow late examinees to test.** Proctors may request photo identification at any time. CBASE exams are given periodically throughout the semester in state-assigned periods. No testing is available outside of these periods. Results are mailed to the Education department and the examinee. Testing Services has no access to scores.
