Acceptable Payment Methods:

The registration fee may be paid with cash, money order or check made out to CC and is due at the time of registration. The CLEP fee is due at the time of the exam and may be paid with a major credit/debit card, money order or check made out to CLEP. No cash may be accepted at the test site.
