Columbia College accepts credit from successfully completed International Baccalaureate (IB) coursework. Course equivalencies and transfer credit award vary by subject and IB course level (standard; higher).

Credit will be granted on a per-course basis for individually completed, higher-level course completed with a score of 5 or better.

Students who have completed the IB Diploma will receive a minimum of 24 semester-hours of credit so long as higher-level (HL) courses have been completed with a score of 4 or better, and standard-level (SL) courses have been completed with a score of 5 or better.
