



The Award: An endowed scholarship fund to honor Dr. Charles W. Kullmann was established through annual gifts from alumni, friends, staff and adjunct faculty. Because Dr. Kullmann is a strong believer in public service, as manifested throughout his life, it is befitting that a scholarship in his honor be volunteer-based.

The individual(s) selected will receive a one-time award of up to \$1,000 to be used for tuition, books and fees at Columbia College. Cash awards will not be made. An individual student cannot receive the scholarship more than one time in an academic year.

Award Criteria: Students chosen to receive these awards will have demonstrated the following:

- Attendance or planned attendance of the Columbia College – St. Louis campus during the 2016-17 Late Summer Semester. (In order to qualify, students must enroll for the Late Summer 2017 session. The scholarship cannot be carried or transferred over into the Early Fall 2017 semester).
- A current 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher with Columbia College or with the most recent school you attended if you have not yet attended Columbia College.
- The application must include the following submission to be considered complete:
 - A personally written 250-word essay on what volunteerism means to the applicant
 - Documentation of current volunteer work (within the past 12 months). Official proof of volunteer activities must be provided by the appropriate agency, club, organization, group, etc.

- Documentation of current volunteer work. Official proof of volunteer activities must be provided by the appropriate agency, club, organization, group, etc. on the company's or organization's letterhead. - *Please attach*
